KEYS TO REMEMBER

- Make good things happen when they are together.
- Monitor body language go at the cat's speed
- Create a daily routine and stick with it
- Providing each cat with Enrichment working with each cat on clicker games, giving separate daily play and snuggle sessions, and providing food puzzles and hunting opportunities for each cat.
- Each cat should have in their safe room: Clean litter boxes, water, food, cat toys, cat trees, hiding spots, and human interaction.
